#### WINTER TOUR ITINERARY

#### Monday - Day 1 (D)

Meet at Delta Calgary Airport Hotel at 10 am.

Travel to the picturesque cowboy town of Cochrane. As you descend the Big Hill into Cochrane, the majestic Rocky Mountains form a wonderful backdrop to the small country town.

Visit the quaint gift stores and cafes along the Main Street and enjoy lunch in one of the old time eateries.

We travel on to our accommodation past the Bow River and Ghost Lake, to the Rocky Ridge Studio.

Enjoy a typical Canadian supper in our cozy lodge.

## Tuesday - Day 2 (B,L)

Meet for brunch with the Cochrane Quilter's Guild.

Enjoy the morning with a 'show and tell' from the Cochrane ladies and a discussion of quilting styles and influences in Australia.

A fabric swatch swap has been organized, so make sure you have room in your luggage for extra fabric!!

Enjoy a visit to the Cochrane Ranchehouse and Cowboy Museum.

## Wednesday – Day 3 (B,L,D)

Stay in the lodge for an all day applique quilting workshop with local quilter, Mary Lou Zuck.

Mary Lou is a talented Baltimore quilter who has constructed blocks for inclusion in Elly Sienkiewicz's 2010 Baltimore Quilting book, "Beloved Baltimore" which was launched at the Houston Quilt Festival.

Take a stroll through snow covered pine forest or sit in front of the cozy fire and stitch, read or chat.

### Thursday – Day 4 (B)

Visit 'Addies Quilt Shop' in Cochrane for a browse and workshop in the morning.

Lunch in one of the quaint cafes in Cochrane's 'old' town.

Afternoon visit to the Cochrane Studio West Art Gallery and Bronze factory, where life sized bronze statues are designed and made.

Special dinner with new Cochrane friends.

## Friday -Day 5 (B)

Travel north into the mountains and be amazed at the magnificence of the Rockies.

We follow the Bow Valley Parkway to Lake Louise and check into the iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise.

Lunch in one of the smaller restaurants in the Chateau, or enjoy a drink from the Lakeview Lounge Lobby Bar, viewing the aweinspiring Victoria Glacier through the bar's signature window.

Explore the historical Chateau Lake Louise with its many wonderful shops and stunning vistas.

Stroll around the grounds and be amazed at the life size ice sculptures of the Ice Magic Festival.

Choose one of the Chateau's 3 restaurants for your evening meal.

#### Saturday – Day 6 (B)

Don a pair of ice skates and venture in and out of the Fairmont Ice Castle sitting on the frozen lake, or take a sleigh ride to the end of Lake Louise and marvel at the frozen ice falls there. You may even see an ice climber scaling the frozen waterfall!

Transportation is available to take you to the Lake Louise Ski Park for sightseeing or skiing.

## Sunday – Day 7 (B)

Drive down to Johnston's Canyon and see the frozen Ice falls.

We may even catch a glimpse of a moose as we drive past Moose Meadows.

We continue on to the mountain village of Canmore.

This pictureseque village is encircled by snow-capped mountain peaks.

Once we are settled in our accommodation, a visit to the famous Sugar Pine Quilting Shop is a must!

The many fabulous Canadian quilt designs in fabric and kits are eye popping.

Wander the village shops to pick up a Canadian souvenir or piece of art work.

Dinner in Canmore.

#### Monday - Day 8 (B,L)

Visit to Canmore's famous Sugar Pine Quilt Shop.

Enjoy browsing through the 2 floors of fabrics and quilt kits.

Choose a half or full day workshop to construct your new project.

Break times throughout the day are planned and meals are included.

Evening with the Canmore Quilters Guild for another Show and Tell and Fabric Swap.

## Tuesday - Day 9 (B)

Travel north for a day in the town of Banff.

Spend the morning strolling the interesting shops and museums

Try 'Tea' at the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel or lunch in one of the quaint cafés or restaurants.
